We need to leave camp by 12:30pm, Sunday.




Dancing will be in the Cypress Room (same place as check-in).

Meals will be in the Houston Dining Hall, next to the fire pit in the Amphitheatre.


Other rooms can be made available for side activities – coordinate with a committee member to set that up.

a - Portland Traveling Morris


b — Goat Hill

Saturday Tours

A couple of quick notes - we do not have pass-the-hat licenses for the city, so please don't bring your own bag. Also, please don't crowd around the dance sites. Leave lots of space so the **audience can see** what's going on (and don't take focus from the team that's performing).

Please be **ready** to board the busses by 9:15am. We have the busses for 8 hours, and we want to make the most of our day in San Francisco, so please be prompt. That way, we all have less bus time and more dance time.

All busses are going to all stops in San Francisco (some stops have multiple performing areas or "stands"). It does not matter which bus you board, so long as you check in with the tour leader on that bus. **Please stay on the same bus throughout the day.** The smallest bus has seat belts, so that is the bus for those with car seats, wheelchairs, and others who need tie-down attachment points.

The busses will be quite full. As in packed. As in we should have NO spare seats. There are overhead racks for personal belongings, and all team gear can go in storage in the outer bus storage compartments.

First stop – we'll begin with a processional of all teams onto the main dance area ending at **Justin Herman plaza**, where teams will join up by "**STAND**" location with the following rotation:

Bus boarding for return trip 4:45 pm. We must be back on the busses quickly. *If you cause the busses to be late and we go over our 8-hour contract, then a rabid tour director will be after your team for the \$75 per hour* overtime bus charges – it won't be pretty.)
