The California Quail, is a "highly sociable bird that often gathers in small flocks called 'coveys.' One of their daily communal activities is a dust bath." (Wikipedia)

The California Qu'Ale, on the other hand, is the 2017 gathering of highly social Morris Dance affiliations, called 'sides' or 'teams,' whose communal activities include making music, dancing, singing, carousing, and the responsible consumption of malt beverages.

Our site, the CYO Retreat Center, is located "amidst 216 acres of towering redwood forest and open meadows in historical western Sonoma County, just six miles from the Pacific Ocean and a short walk away from the town of Occidental."

Amenities include: heated cabins, modern bathing facilities (no dust baths!), basketball and volleyball courts, heated swimming pool (extra charge NOT included in Ale fee); a horseshoe pit, campfire sites, and a full-service kitchen.

- Take Highway #101 to Santa Rosa. Take the Highway #12 West-Sebastopol/Bodega Bay exit.
- Follow Highway #12 through Sebastopol.

- Continue for 8 miles until you reach the Bohemian Highway turnoff at Freestone (there will be a small green sign on the right marked "Freestone/Occidental").
- Turn right onto Bohemian Highway and continue for almost 2 miles. CYO Retreat Center is located on the left side of the road.
- Cross to the entrance carefully, and continue up the hill to the parking lot.

The registration fee for this year's California Qu'Ale is \$175 per person until April 22, at which time the fee will increase to \$195. In addition to your accommodations, the fee includes Saturday and Sunday breakfasts; and a banquet dinner Saturday (NOT roast quail, thank you!). Of course, there will be bus tours to the environs – Sebastopol, Santa Rosa, and the Russian River area – on Saturday, with a stop for lunch and show dances (box lunch provided), and a pub stop, or possibly two (bar tab NOT included in Ale fee). Friday and Saturday nights we will be offering local craft ales and ciders, and snacks.

Workshops will be available Sunday morning if someone wants to teach them. Please indicate your interest and availability on the registration form.
